

## Scratch Installation



### Getting started: your first steps in IT

The Scratch program can be used both **online** directly in the **browser** (on the website) and offline with a downloadable editor. To start, create an **account** on the site and continue working in the browser from there. You will need a good internet connection (at least 15 Mbps) to do this. The advantage of the online version is that all changes are automatically saved.

To download the offline editor, please follow the [link](#) and select your operating system version. After that, click on the **Direct download** button to start the download. Once the file has finished downloading, run it to install it on your device.



As soon as the installation is completed, a **shortcut** will appear on your desktop, clicking on which will open Scratch.



## Scratch registration and site terms of use

1. Go to the website.  
Click on the **Join Scratch** button



2. Next, you need to come up with a **name** (using letters, numbers and signs), as well as a **password**.






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5. Now you can click "Create" to open the program itself:
